

How to face a 5:0+1 defence



A: NED in attack with pivot-RB



After requesting the ball and RB's run to the inside the pivot profits from the defence's anticipation of RB that causes open space in the back of the left half-defender.









Given that the defence closed the gap, the pivot passes to the right wing.









Based on that delayed pass the right wing prepares for a perfect shot at the goal to score with a nice wide shooting angle.





B: The following picture row shows another spectacular situation for that age category with excellent technical skills.



The right back is in possession of the ball and the attack shifts to the centre when the centre back requires the ball.



The right back crosses with the centre back.







The centre back moves to the wing to attack the gap.



Pass with help of an excellent Kempa executed by the centre back and the right wing







A perfect timing proves the high quality as concerns technical skills.
