Individual quality

The Congo Team traditionally presents a game based on the individual qualities of each player. They manage to surprise the opponent at any time during the match. The qualities of feints and explosivity allows them to beat the direct opponent in any space.



Picture 1. Congo's numerical superiority in attack 6x5: CB passes to the LB 7 who receives the ball in the left outside position.



Picture 2. LB 7 runs slowly inside and makes a feint with the ball. He changes quickly his direction, dribbles and runs in the open space between the two defenders.



Picture 3. The outside defender doesn't move inside. The space remains open and free for the LB. He runs forward quickly through the open space.



Picture 4. The LB manages to jump between the two defenders who are inside the goal area. He keeps a good balance on air.



Picture 5. The outside defender imbalances the LB who tries to score a goal with a specific shot.



Picture 6. The goalkeeper has anticipated the LB's shooting position: he moves forward to close the shooting angle and to reduce the shooting choices. The LB is imbalanced.



Picture 7. The goalkeeper stops the ball. But the LB obtains a 7m.
