- rEPO: recombinant erythropoietin. These pharmaceutical substances are known by their INN as “epoetin”. The different preparations are identified by a Greek letter, e.g. epoetin- α , - β , - γ , - δ . Other preparations (e.g. generics or copies) referred collectively as “rEPO biosimilars” may have differing isoform profiles not exactly matching those already referenced.
- uEPO: endogenous erythropoietin (secreted naturally by the athlete's own tissues) as excreted in urine.
