It will be the second IHF World Championship in Greece after the Men's Junior World Championship in 1991. Since then Greek handball has improved, proven not only by the sixth place of the Hellenic men's team at the Olympics 2004, which has been the greatest success in the history of Greek handball and was followed by the sixth place at the Men's World Championship 2005 in Tunisia. Those milestones were the beginning of the Hellenic handball movement. Players from Greece have now found top clubs all over Europe and the improvement has lasted until the present day.



Now a new generation of Greek and international handball youngsters will meet in Greece and compete for the Junior World Championship title. 24

However it is also an important objective for the hosting nation: Organising a World Championship will bring our sport into the focus of fans, sponsors and media – and I hope this competition will be another great step for the development of handball in Greece.



24 national teams have qualified for the 2011 World Championship. They are entitled to take part provided they have fulfilled their obligations towards the IHF.


Date of competition




CITY OF THESSALONIKI

Thessaloniki is Greece's second largest city and is fast becoming the powerhouse of the Balkans. Its current population is estimated to be over one million inhabitants. Founded in 316 BC, Thessaloniki was named after the half-sister of Alexander the Great.

Situated at the crossroads between east and west, this multicultural metropolis has a dramatic history of conquests and counter-invasions.

Nowadays, Thessaloniki is a prosperous waterfront city, its sophisticated business centre balanced by a lively student culture. The Aristotle University, founded in 1925, is Greece's largest







Thessaloniki's port is a European port and the natural gateway for the economic activities of the inland markets beyond Greece. The port is a vital element of the country's economy while it also plays a substantial role in the Eastern Mediterranean.

The city's docklands have been transformed into post-industrial bars, restaurants and galleries. Thessaloniki is the most important cultural centre of Balkans. Many cultural institutions are located in Thessaloniki. At the Archaeological Museum, collections of Archaic to Late Roman findings from Thessaloniki and Macedonia in general are displayed. The Museum of Byzantine Culture

presenting various aspects of life during the byzantine and post-byzantine

periods: art, ideology, social structure and religion. The Sport Museum presenting and preserving the sport heritage and the promotion of the cultural side of sport, missions that are accomplished in actual fact through permanent or temporary sport exhibitions. In January 2008, the International Olympic Committee recognised the Museum as the first Olympic Museum of the country, with the name THESSALONIKI OLYMPIC MUSEUM. Thessaloniki's air transports are served from the "Makedonia" international airport with a lot of direct flights to various destinations abroad. Also a number of other infrastructure projects such as the "Egnatia Odos



number of other infrastructure projects such as the "Egnatia Odos" highway ensure good road access to Thessaloniki.

There are frequent bus, trains and plane services to most parts of Greece as well as railway connection with many European countries. The large seaside front, the traditional squares and alleys, the famous nightlife as well as the easy access to wonderful nearby beaches, will prove an excellent opportunity for all participants and spectators to combine an athletic event with leisure, tourism and entertainment.





Participating teams

Player eligibility

Players born in 1990 or later are eligible to play.

All players are subject to the Eligibility Code for handball players. For proof of citizenship, players must show a passport, which will be checked by the Commission of Organising and Competition (COC) before the start of the World Championship. The minimum age for participation according to the IHF Regulations is 16.

Team registration

Up to 28 players and the remainder as officials (stating their function) shall be registered with the Head Office in Basle as follows:

provisionally: one month (17 June 2011) before the World Championship at the latest (28 players at

most) to the organiser as well as the IHF Head Office

definitively: one hour before the Technical Meeting to the responsible IHF representative (16

players taken from the provisional list). Registration must be executed on the relevant

IHF form.

If a team has registered less than 16 players, it may register one additional player during the World Championship.

<u>During</u> the WCh each team may replace up to two players (against two players indicated in the provisional list) at any time. It means that every team may replace <u>a maximum</u> of two players at any time during the competition. These two players may be replaced against players indicated in the provisional delegation list ('list of 28').

Registration on the IHF form for that very purpose (see attached form) must contain the following information in English:





- a) Officials
 Last name, first name, date of birth, gender, function in the delegation and indication of the officials (using letters A, B, C, D, E, F)
- Players
 Player's number, last name, first name, date of birth, club, height, weight, number of international games and number of goals scored (in the corresponding WCh category).
- Players' clothing
 Colour of first and second set of clothing, separately for shirts and shorts; goalkeepers' first and second set of clothing

Players who have not officially registered by the date stipulated shall not be allowed to play in the competition. Please be notified that it is not allowed to take the role as both a player and official simultaneously.

Players' clothing

Players' clothing worn at the 2011 Men's Junior World Championship shall be subject to the Regulations for IHF Competitions and the Equipment Manual respectively.

Each team shall dispose of two sets of clothing in different colours.

- a) One set of light-coloured shirts and one set of light-coloured shorts;
- b) One set of dark-coloured shirts and one set of dark-coloured shorts;
- c) Three differently coloured shirts for the goalkeeper (In one match the same colour of all goalkeepers' shirts is needed.)
- d) One colour should very clearly cover the major part of the shirt.

The players' shirts shall bear the player's number as prescribed below.



If the players' shirts shall bear the player's name, it must be displayed as prescribed below.







Competition Management

The Competition Management is responsible for the orderly management of the event, in close cooperation with the organiser. It gives advice and makes all the necessary decisions during the event, with the exception of disciplinary decisions. It is also responsible for the appointment of Officials, Technical Delegates and Referees. The teams may contact the IHF hotel (details as below) to reach the Competition Management.

Rules of the Game

Matches shall be played according to the current Rules of the Game.

As you may know, the IHF Council adopted changes to the Rules of the Game, which had been put forward to the Congress for ratification. At the Men's Junior World Championship 2011 the following regulations will apply.

16 players may be put in per match

16 players may be put in per match at World Championships and related qualifying rounds.

Half-time break

The half-time break at the Men's Junior World Championship 2011 shall be 15 minutes.

Team-Time Out

According to Rule 2:10 and Clarification 3 of the Rules of the Game each team has the right to receive a maximum of three team time-outs during regular playing time but not during overtime. No more than two team time-outs may be granted in each half of the regular playing time. Between two team time-outs of a team, the opponent must be at least once in possession of the ball. 3 green cards, bearing numbers 1, 2, and 3 respectively, are available for each team. The teams receive cards bearing numbers '1' and '2' in the first half of the game and the cards no. 2 and no. 3 in the second half provided they received no more than one team time-out in the first half. In case they received two team time-outs in the first half, they receive only green card no. 3.

Within the last 5 minutes of the regular playing time only one team time-out per team is allowed.





Technical Meeting

A Technical Meeting with the team officials of the participating delegations, the organiser and the IHF representatives shall be held on 17 July 2011 at 9.00am at the Team Hotel to provide all necessary information and to settle organisational, technical and financial issues.

The teams have to bring all **players' passports** and a sample of their **players' uniform** sets to the Technical Meeting. Moreover they are to submit the **definitive registration list** by use of the IHF form. May we point out once again that only players indicated in the provisional registration list submitted to the IHF may be included in the definitive registration list.

Mixed referee couples

Attention is drawn to the fact that the so called 'mixed referee couples project' will be tested again in certain matches of the 2011 Men's Junior World Championship in Greece. It means that referees from different countries will form a couple to whistle a match.

Official balls

Balls of IHF partner Select will be used at the Men's Junior World Championship. All participating teams received 10 balls in advance to get familiar with the balls.

IHF representatives

The IHF Referees appointed to the individual matches will only be announced on the relevant matchday. The Technical Delegates and the Referees will be informed accordingly in the morning of the relevant matchday at 10 o'clock. The teams and the general public may read the nominations on the IHF website (www.ihf.info) at 11 o'clock.

Video recordings

Generally speaking all teams are allowed to take video recordings, although some restrictions may be necessary on account of the space available. The organiser shall provide a special place in the hall for the person taking the video.

One person from each team is allowed to take video recordings at the hall. Recordings may only be used for internal purposes or for developing team tactics and must not be commercially exploited.

Match DVDs

The organiser undertakes to record the matches. One match DVD shall be available for the teams concerned free of charge. Further DVD copies may be purchased at a price of CHF 30.--.

Scouting system

The IHF and the organiser assure the data processing to produce all match-relevant statistics. All statistics could be found on www.ihf.info. All delegates are requested to work close together with our scouting partner and support them in any regard.





Commemorative medals

All IHF nominees shall receive commemorative medals.

Closing banquet


Depending on the travel schedule of the teams, the organiser may prepare a closing banquet for the participating delegations and the IHF representatives.

Preliminary Round

The preliminary round is played in groups. Matches shall be evaluated as follows:

- each match won = 2 points
- each match drawn = 1 point for each team
- each match lost = no points

Teams are ranked according to the total number of points gained.

If two or more teams have gained the same number of points after the group matches have been completed, classification is decided as follows:

- results in points between the teams concerned;
- goal differences in the matches between the teams concerned;
- greater number of plus goals in the matches between the teams concerned.

If the teams are still equal, a decision is made between those teams with an equal number of points as follows:

- goal difference is subtracted in all matches
- greater number of plus goals in all matches

If classification still is not possible, a draw shall decide. The IHF representative on site shall execute the draw, if possible in the presence of the 'responsible team officials'. If the 'responsible team official' cannot be present, other co-workers selected by the IHF shall take part.

Placement Round, Placement Matches, Eighth-Finals, Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals

After completion of the preliminary rounds, all matches shall be played in accordance with the knock-out system.

In case of a draw at the end of the regular playing time, after a break of five (5) minutes, a first overtime period of 2 x 5 minutes shall be played, changing sides halfway through with a one-minute break in-between. Provisions to the contrary set for individual tournaments shall be given priority.

If the match should still not be decided after this overtime period, after a break of 5 minutes, a second overtime period of 2 x 5 minutes shall be played, changing ends halfway through with a one minute break in-between.





Should the match still not be decided after the second overtime period, it is decided with 7m penalty throws in accordance with Rule 2:2 of the Rules of the Game.


In case of a draw at the end of the regular playing time of placement matches 17th-24th, 13th-16th and 11th-12th, 7m throws shall be executed to decide the match in accordance with Rule 2:2 of the Rules of the Game.

Cancellation or discontinuation of match

If the match is cancelled or discontinued, the Competition Management shall decide on further action.

A post-match press conference will take place approximately 15 minutes after the end of each match in the press conference room, located close to other media areas. A coach and a player from each team will attend the press conference conducted in English.

Advertising on sportswear


Rights in respect of advertising on sportswear are laid down in the Regulations for Advertising and the Equipment Manual.


